Suggested Guidance For Students

Ensure that you understand your rights & responsibilities in relation to an alleged violation of the "[Code of Academic Integrity](#)"

Ask, Consult/Meet, Understand, Sign & Submit, Participate

Ask the faculty or staff member for a copy of the *Charge of Academic Dishonesty Form*; **Ask** them to review the evidence of the alleged violation(s).

Consult and/or **Meet** with the Office of Academic Integrity to discuss what your rights & responsibilities are in relation to the alleged violation(s).

- Students should review the "[Code of Academic Integrity](#)" available online.
- Students may also consult with an advisor, which could include family members or another individual.

Understand what specific alleged violation(s) of the "[Code of Academic Integrity](#)" you are being charged with: Cheating, Fabrication, Plagiarism, Falsification and Forgery of University Academic Documents, and/or Facilitating Academic Dishonesty.

Understand what the potential sanction(s) are and how they may affect your academic status within the course, within the academic school or college, and at the university.

Understand whether or not the alleged violation(s) must be addressed through an Academic Integrity Council Hearing.

Understand what a Hearing is and what its procedures are.

Understand what your rights are as a student in a Hearing.

Sign & Submit the *Charge of Academic Dishonesty Form* to the Office of Academic Integrity or the faculty or staff member.

- This indicates your acknowledgement of how the alleged violation(s) of the "[Code of Academic Integrity](#)" will be addressed by the university.

Participate in any meetings or Hearings requested and/or required of you through the Academic Integrity Disciplinary Process.

Suggested Guidance For Faculty & Staff

Help ensure the standards of the "[Code of Academic Integrity](#)" by following these six suggested steps for addressing alleged violations:

Collect, Verify, Write, Present, Allow, Submit

Collect information associated with the alleged violation(s) of the "[Code of Academic Integrity](#)" (documents, papers, emails, etc.). You may also consult with colleagues or our office about the alleged violation(s).

Verify if the student(s) has a previous "[Code of Academic Integrity](#)" violation by contacting the Office of Academic Integrity at (202) 994-6757 or via email at rights@gwu.edu.

Write a [Charge of Academic Dishonesty Form](#) for each individual student involved.

- Identify the applicable violation(s): Cheating, Fabrication, Plagiarism, Falsification and Forgery of University Academic Documents, and/or Facilitating Academic Dishonesty.
- Propose a sanction consistent with the nature of the violation, your syllabus, academic college regulations, and/or university recommendations.

Present the completed *Charge of Academic Dishonesty Form* and any documentation of the alleged violation(s) to the student at an in-person meeting, if possible.

- Walk the student through the alleged violation(s) and the proposed sanction in a constructive conversation about the importance of Academic Integrity within the classroom.
- Refer the student to our office so that they can understand their rights and the university's Academic Integrity Disciplinary Process

Allow the student time to consider a course of action in relation to the alleged violation(s), typically **at least three (3) business days**.

- The Office of Academic Integrity, in consultation with the faculty or staff member, will direct any final deadline established for the student.

Submit the signed and completed *Charge of Academic Dishonesty Form* to the Office of Academic Integrity, along with any documentation associated to the alleged violation(s).

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Upon Submission, the Office of Academic Integrity will proceed with the Elected Action of the Student or the Action Mandated by the "[Code of Academic Integrity](#)"
